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INTRODUCTION

The fundamentals of using Bluebeam are covered in this instructor-led course, spanning over one day. The course focuses on the software that gives students the ability to manage, mark up, and collaborate on PDFs for architectural and construction projects by providing an in-depth understanding of workflows and key features.

This course teaches students how to use Bluebeam in a way that mirrors real-world project environments.

You start by becoming familiar with the user interface and profiles in Bluebeam, followed by mastering PDF management and document manipulation techniques. The course then progresses to document automation, markups, and the use of stamps. Finally, students will learn about tool chests, collaboration tools, and workflow efficiencies.

The goal of this course is to equip students with the skills necessary to efficiently handle PDF documents and enhance collaboration within their teams.
